



## High-pressure water jets remove dried concrete

**A** new high-pressure water jet system for removing the buildup of dried concrete in cement mixer trucks is being made available in Australia.

The traditional method for removing dead concrete known as de-dagging requires a labourer to chip away the ac-

cumulated concrete with a jackhammer inside the barrel of the truck.

The Agi-Kleen water blasting system reduces occupational health and safety risks, with the equipment technician working outside the truck's mixing drum.

The system removes the concrete

without damage or wear to the drum.

While de-dagging can take up to eight hours, the Agi-Kleen system can remove concrete in two hours.

All water used to remove the dead concrete is recycled to make fresh concrete. [agikleen.com.au](http://agikleen.com.au)
